Entries: Entries accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. **Only complete entries** will be accepted and processed. Late fee \$10

COMPLETE ENTRIES: Must include:

- a) Filled out digisigner class entry form and liability release form. If snail mail: If mailing, take a picture of it and email it to secretary in case of slow snail mail.
- b) Upload a negative Coggins within 12 months of show date on the website registration or email/mail a copy to secretary: Rita Moore, 116 Jay St, Scotia, NY 12302.
- c) a. Register and Pay online on our website or b. check made out to ENYDCTA Ltd & mail to: Jenn Saunders, 603 Stoney Brook Rd, Schoharie, NY 12157

Please be kind to the secretary and get entries in ASAP.

Management:

-Reserves the right to combine or split classes based on the number of entries.

-Reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason.

-TOC classes may be entered multiple times by the same horse/rider combination, but a different test must be ridden each time.

-All classes run under USEF/USEA/USDF/WDAA rules

-Inclement Weather: Show will be held rain or shine.

Returned Checks or Electronic Payment Refusal: A fee of \$25 will be assessed for any returned check or electronic payment refusal. This fee, along with the entry fees, must then be paid by cash, certified check, or money order. Failure may be subject to revocation of ENYDCTA membership.

Awards: Six ribbons per class, High point of the day dressage champion ribbon, High point of the day combined training champion ribbon.

Year End awards: schooling show series, available on the ENYDCTA website.

Food: No food on site at both shows.

Small arena:

USDF intro & training

USEA beginner A&B, novice A&B, training A&B, modified A&B, preliminary test A&B, intermediate test C, novice 3-day

WDAA intro & basic

Standard arena (large arena):

USDF first Level to grand prix

USEA preliminary test C, intermediate A&B, modified C, advanced test A&B, training 3-day

WDAA Levels 1 through 5

Maiden – These tests are for a rider where this is their first year competing. This division is not restricted by age.

Competition Attire: "Clinic attire" is acceptable (neat and tidy). You MUST wear boot with a heel; protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards, and is properly fitted with harness secured; a sleeved shirt tucked in your breeches. Half chaps may be worn.

Required for Safety: properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds American Society for Testing and Materials / Safety Equipment Institute ("SEI") standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag ("Protective Headgear") while riding anywhere on the event grounds at any time during the ENYDCTA event.

Riding a test twice on same horse:

The same horse/rider combination may enter and ride the same test twice but only the first ride will count toward placing in the class and toward the Year End Awards. The second ride must be ridden hors concours.
