A USDF Bronze, Silver, and Gold medalist, Jeff started riding as a boy in his native New Mexico. In 1983, he took the first of many clinics from Charles de Kunffy, whose influence continues to impact Jeff's riding today. Jeff earned Bachelor's degree in mathematics from Lafayette College in Easton, Pennsylvania in 1992, and a Master's degree in Architecture from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, NY in 1995. While practicing as an architect, he continued to pursue his dressage riding and training, and in 2000 opened his own facility to work as a professional trainer and instructor. The analytical, reflective and visual nature of Jeff's schooling as a mathematician and architect

influences the way he works with horses and riders. Over the years, Jeff has been fortunate to receive instruction from many notable equestrians.
