While absent, Jennifer Saunders provided a report to the board on finances.

Joy introduced Vicki Hurewitz the clubs new Corresponding Secretary who is interested in setting up a database with local boarding barns and trainers for ENYDCTA to use for marketing and communications.

Joy also introduced Peter Tkaczyk who is our new webmaster. He was not able to attend the meeting.

It was asked that the Board review and approve the minutes. The motion was carried.

Regional Championship – Laura was able to get 13 volunteers. Center Line is paying \$75 for scribes and \$50 for stewards who require housing and lunch, those who don't will be paid \$100 and \$75 respectively. This was a great turn outcome.
